

POWELL RIVER REGIONAL DISTRICT

BYLAW No. 523, 2017

**Being a bylaw to convert and establish the service of waste management
in the Powell River Regional District.**

WHEREAS by Supplementary Letters Patent dated 11/23/70 granted the Powell River Regional District the authority to provide the function of garbage disposal within Electoral Areas A, B, C and the Corporation of the District of Powell River (now the City of Powell River);

AND WHEREAS by Supplementary Letters Patent dated 09/27/74 granted the Powell River Regional District the authority to add Electoral Area D to the function of garbage disposal;

AND WHEREAS by Supplementary Letters Patent dated 10/04/75 redefined the boundaries of Electoral Area D and created Electoral Area E;

AND WHEREAS the *Local Government Act* authorizes the Regional District Board to convert a function established by supplementary letters patent to a service exercised under the authority of a bylaw establishing the service;

AND WHEREAS the Board of the Powell River Regional District wishes to convert the function of garbage disposal to a service exercised under the authority of an establishing bylaw;

AND WHEREAS the written consent of at least two thirds of all the participants in the service area has been obtained in accordance with the *Local Government Act*;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board of Directors of the Powell River Regional District, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

1. **CONVERSION**

The function of garbage disposal as granted by Division VIII of Supplementary Letters Patent dated 11/23/70 and further amended by Supplementary Letters Patent dated 09/27/74 is hereby converted and established as the "Waste Management Conversion and Service Establishment Bylaw No. 523, 2017. Notwithstanding the generality of the foregoing, this service may include the acquisition and operation of a landfill site, a resource recovery facility which may include composting and other recycling activities, a transfer station, and any other operation for the reduction or disposal of solid waste.

2. **SERVICE AREA BOUNDARIES**

The boundaries of the service area are the whole of the City of Powell River and Electoral Areas A, B, C, D and E.

3. **PARTICIPATING AREAS**

The participants in the service area are the City of Powell River and Electoral Areas A, B, C, D and E of the Powell River Regional District.

4. **COST RECOVERY**

The annual cost of providing the service shall be recovered by either or both of the following:

- i) the requisition of money to be collected by property value taxes levied on the net taxable value of land and improvements in the service area;
- ii) the implementation of fees and charges as may be established by separate bylaw.

5. **APPORTIONMENT**

Costs will be apportioned on the basis of the converted value of land and improvements for hospital district purposes in the service area.


6. **MAXIMUM REQUISITION**


The maximum amount that may be requisitioned for this service is \$0.366 per \$1,000 of net taxable value of land and improvements in the service area, or \$1,200,000, whichever is higher.

7. **CITATION**

This Bylaw may be cited as the "Waste Management Conversion and Service Establishment Bylaw No. 523, 2017.
