

Savary Island Barge Site

INFORMATION SHEET

The qathet Regional District holds a 5-year Licence Of Occupation from March 31, 2018 to March 30, 2023 with the BC Ministry of Forests Lands and Natural Resource Operations. The tenure is for 0.0151 hectares of foreshore and land under water as indicated on the map below.

The barge ramp is for the loading and unloading of supplies for short periods of time. During all other times the foreshore will remain accessible to the public. There is no storing of boats or vehicles, materials or equipment, and no swimming or moorings within the tenure site. Barge site users are also asked to not leave vehicles or cargo in the road right of way in the immediate vicinity of the licenced barge site.

All barges using this facility must have a *Sub-Licence Management and Safety Plan* in good standing, and be equipped with adequate spill kits in the event of a spill. Spill supplies are also stored at the barge site at the entrance to the barge ramp. No fuel transfer (container to container, vessel to vehicle, vehicle to vessel, or container to vessel) is permitted on the Licence Area.

Hours/Days of Operation and Minimum Tide

6:00AM to 6:00PM from May 1 through September 30 each year.

Each barge operator is restricted to a maximum of 5 days per week as per their sub-licence agreement. Tide must be at least 1 metre for loading/unloading at the site.

Speed Limit on Malaspina Promenade

Please limit your speed on Malaspina to 20km/h maximum. Leave ample time before departure, and drive slowly after unloading off of barge. Always watch for pedestrians.
