Dinner Rock Campground re-opening Today

The Dinner Rock campground has resolved its safety issues for visitors by removing a number of danger trees that were identified, and will re-open safely in the early afternoon of Friday June 5th, as part of the Provincial Restart Plan. These plans are in alignment with the Regional Emergency Operations Centre. Our apologies for the inconvenience, but the safety of our visitors, and our local residents is of great importance to us.

As a reminder, practice safe distancing by maintaining at least two meters distance from other campers when enjoying our campgrounds. Users are expected to follow all recommendations and protocols if experiencing symptoms of Covid-19, as outlined by health authorities. Signage has been posted for the benefit of you and other campsite users. Dinner Rock campground is not a place to recover from Covid-19 if you are experiencing symptoms. Please do not visit our campgrounds if you are experiencing symptoms of Covid-19 or have been exposed to anyone experiencing symptoms.
