



# Tla'amin Lifts Shelter-in-Place Order

For Immediate Release- September 17, 2020  
Tla'amin Territory, Powell River, BC

Today at 5:00 pm, the third 72-hour Shelter-in-place expires. A decision was made by the Executive Council to lift the order and allow our members to get back to the new normal prior to Labor Day. Community members are reminded to follow the Covid- 19 safety measures from the Provincial Health Officer.

The Shelter-in-Place will remain in effect until 5:00 p.m. today.

1. The curfew of 9 pm to 6 am remains in effect;
2. Non-residents are not granted access into the Nation with the exception of established contractors and delivery companies;
3. One point of entry and one point of exit to the community be designated; and,
4. Members are advised to continue to self-isolate if they are not feeling well, practice physical distancing and always wear masks when in public.

Hegus Clint Williams, "Executive Council has determined we can move forward with incremental steps to ensure the safety at the checkpoints. It is now the responsibility for our members to follow all safety measures to ensure that we avoid going down this pandemic path once again. We will proceed with extreme caution."

Tla'amin people have come together to ensure that every Nation member has what they need to stay safe or to recover. Now, we must ensure/continue that all Tla'amin people can play a part in shaping the future of our nation. We realize this is yet another change in an already difficult time."
