From the Area C Director....

February was an interesting month – weather wise, especially. A lot of people had trouble with the snow (myself included) but luckily we don't have to endure those conditions very often. I did bring the issue of clearing the side roads up with MOTI but I think it's more a matter of not having the equipment to quickly deal with that volume of snow than the area being ignored. That being said, hopefully they'll give the side roads a higher priority in the future.

The RD is still working through the budget for 2019 but we'll have it all wrapped up in March. Amongst the items that have been approved is the operating grant for the Kelly Creek Community School Association. Kevin and Laurie do a great job and I love seeing how much the Community House is utilized. Another item that has been approved is a wood stove rebate program that will provide (on a first come first serve basis) \$350 for the exchange of an uncertified wood stove to an EPA-certified wood stove or electric fireplace insert and \$550 for an exchange from an uncertified wood stove to an EPA-certified pellet fueled appliance, a natural gas or propane fueled appliance or an electric heat pump. Contact the RD if you're interested.

Also in February I attended a three-day conference in Parksville where I learned a lot about how to be an elected official and the resources that are available to me. I'm in the middle of a steep learning curve but the RD is doing a great job providing me with the tools I need to be successful. I also attended a meeting of the Library Board and the recent strike vote by the CUPE staff was the main topic of conversation. The Library Board is hopeful that resolutions to the outstanding issues will be found quickly and fairly through mediation. Our aim is to come to an agreement that is fair and reasonable. The library and the services it offers are a real asset to the community and no one wants to see the doors closed, even temporarily. If you utilize it you'll know what I'm talking about, and if you don't, you should make your way over there and take in all it has to offer! You won't regret it.
