

5 questions about the COVID-19 vaccine

1. Why should I get vaccinated?

Getting vaccinated is the best way to protect yourself, the people you love, and your community against COVID-19.

2. Is the vaccine safe?

A lot of research has shown that the COVID vaccines approved in Canada are safe. The vaccines are proven to protect people from COVID-19.

3. Do I still have to wear a mask if I have been vaccinated?

Yes. It is not yet clear if you can still carry the virus once you have been vaccinated. For this reason Public Health is asking everyone to continue to wear a mask and follow other guidelines, even after vaccination.

4. When can I get vaccinated?
