WOOD STOVE EXCHANGE PROGRAM

The Wood Stove Exchange Program is administered by the **qathet Regional District (qRD)** and is open to all residents in the qathet Regional District. Wood Stove Exchange Program rebates are limited and available on a first-come, first-served basis.

Additional rebates may be available at local retailers and online through betterhomesbc.ca, bchydro.com and powellriver.ca

Conditions

- Only one rebate per taxable residence per year.
- A second-hand heating appliance does not qualify as a replacement appliance.
- The value of the rebate must not exceed the value of the new heating appliance.
- Rebate tracking numbers are required and will be issued through the qathet Regional District. Please contact **Let's Talk Trash** at 604.485.2260 ext.308 or email: info@letstalktrash.ca.
- Both the old wood stove and the new heating appliance must meet the rebate program requirements. For more details visit: qathet.ca/services/waste-management/wood-stove-exchange-program

To Receive the Rebate:

- The old wood stove must be inspected by a Wood Energy Technical Training (WETT) certified technician to verify the appliance is not up to current EPA certification.
- If you are replacing an old wood burning appliance with a new wood burning appliance, the WETT certified technician must certify that the new appliance and chimney meet current WETT and current safety certified standards.

STEP 1: Qualification

To qualify, the appliance being replaced must be:

- presently used as a primary heating source.
- a non-EPA-certified appliance. (A WETT certified technician such as your retailer or chimney sweep can assist you in verifying that your appliance is non-EPA certified).

STEP 2: Application Process

Applicants must pre-qualify by email, phone or in person to receive a tracking number. Let's Talk Trash is happy to assist you with your rebate application.

STEP 3: Disposal of Old Wood Stove

To improve qathet Regional District air quality, to prevent old wood stoves from being reused by someone else and to ensure proper recycling, old wood stoves must be permanently disabled and can be dropped off at one of the following recycling centres: Augusta Recyclers, Black Point Auto Salvage, Hi-Ball Auto Recycling or Wilde Road Sand & Gravel and signed off by an attendant or WETT certified technician.

- Doors removed and door hinges bludgeoned
- Ash and brick liner removed
- Flue collar bludgeoned

NOTE: You are responsible for obtaining the appropriate building permit required for installation of a new wood burning appliance.

We require the signature of a WETT certified technician to verify that the old wood stove is not up to current EPA certification.

STEP 4: Submit Application

Make sure you provide:

- A copy of purchase receipt
- A copy of WETT inspection report, if applicable
- Both sides of this brochure completed
- A photo of the old wood burning appliance installed in the home.
- A photo of the new, properly installed appliance

Please ensure that this application is completed in full and that all requested supporting documents are attached. The qRD will mail you a rebate cheque within six weeks of receiving your application. The deadline for submitting your application is November 30, 2022.
