From the Area C Director....

Well, it's been a busy month, that's for sure. We kicked it off with the swearing-in ceremony on the 1st and followed it up with Board Orientation, an online law seminar, and at the inaugural board meeting, I was voted in as Chair. As Chair I will have a few new responsibilities, the first of which was to lay a wreath at the cenotaph on Remembrance Day. I was honored to be asked to take part in the ceremony.

There were a few items this month that may be of particular interest to people south of town. The first is that the land just south of the Lang Creek Fish Hatchery has been supported for subdivision by the qathet Regional District (qRD). This is a very simple subdivision and only splits the land into two lots – one below the highway and one above. One of the requests made with the subdivision is that parking is provided for those who wish to visit Mahood's Beach. The final decision is made by the Ministry of Transportation and Infrastructure but they like to have the support of the local government. The second is that the Rotary Club is planning on building a gazebo down at Palm Beach Park for the public to use. They're intending on locating it near the beach and close to the cluster of trees - I'm sure it will get a ton of use! Last but not least, the qRD approved a Grant in Aid for Lang Bay Hall to pay for outdoor lighting with 2/3 of the money coming from Area C and 1/3 of the money coming from Area B. The existing outdoor lighting, which has been supplied by BC Hydro, is no longer going to be supported by them, so this will fill the void. The new lighting will enhance public safety for Lang Bay Hall attendees, transit riders, and allow for more outdoor evening activities.

A few other items of interest are that the bell from St. Gerard's Catholic Church will be relocated to the Powell River Regional Cemetery Mausoleum, and the qRD has adopted a new Parks, Properties, and Trails Volunteers Policy. The church has been deconsecrated and the property is going to be sold so moving the historic bell seemed like the right thing to do. The new Volunteers Policy outlines how local groups can contribute to the maintenance and enhancement of qRD public land. Hopefully many groups take advantage of this new policy – it's another opportunity for the public to contribute to make our community better for all.

November also included the second round of financial assistance grants, one of which was already mentioned above. The qRD, through the Grants in Aid, Social Planning and Economic Development grants, supported the Texada Sandcastle Weekend, Lasqueti Food Bank, qathet Pride, LIFT, qathet Art, and qathet Old Growth for the production of their 2022 qathet Day for Remembrance of Lost Species, amongst others.
