



NON-RESIDENT PROPERTY ELECTOR CONSENT FORM

HOW TO COMPLETE THIS FORM: If there are two (2) or more property owners, you must decide among yourselves as to which one of you will be able to register to vote. It must be a majority of the property owners who consent in writing to giving you the vote. So, if there are only two (2) of you on title, you both must sign the consent form. If there are three (3) of you, then two (2) of you must sign the consent form. If there are four (4) of you, then three (3) of you must sign the consent form and so on.

We, together with the person registering, constitute a majority of registered owners of the real property noted below and hereby give consent to:
