From the Area C Director....

Summer is just about upon us which means the South of Town Events page will take a short break even though it's business as usual at the qathet Regional District (qRD). I have asked the contributors to consider the next three months when promoting their events but if I hear about anything that isn't in the newsletter, I'll place it on my Facebook page and on the qathet South Facebook group.

May was a bit light on items that would be of particular interest to Area C residents other than the proposed changes to the Areas A, B and C Official Community Plans (OCPs). The lack of affordable rental accommodations in the qRD has been a subject of great interest the past few years and it's not going away anytime soon. Sewer and water services don't exist in most of the area outside of the municipality which means the qRD has limited tools with which to increase the rental accommodation inventory. Secondary suites have been a great way for property owners to create living spaces and earn additional income but in many cases the OCPs contained policy that discouraged property owners from developing secondary suites. The qRD Planning Department has prepared draft amending bylaws for the Electoral Area A, B and C OCPs that will ensure a consistent policy approach across the region in regards to secondary suites and accessory dwelling units (essentially suites that are not attached to the main house). These changes should make secondary suites an option for more property owners because they make Vancouver Coastal Health regulations that require there to be adequate sewer servicing and water supply the standard instead of lot size minimums. The proposed OCP amendments also align with Provincial priorities outlined in their "Homes for People Action Plan" which is meant to increase the affordable rental accommodations inventory across the province. Some of the key changes are as follows:

- Replacing the term "single family dwelling" with "residential dwelling"
- Secondary suites supported
- Common definitions across the OCPs
- Accessory dwelling units supported as an accessory use subject to proof of water and sewer servicing that meets provincial standards
- Density provisions removed and replaced with a condition for proof of water and sewer servicing that meets provincial standards

The motions to give first and second readings of the new amending bylaws for Areas A and C were approved but Area B's was defeated. Staff will be holding public information meetings prior to third and final reading of the bylaws.
