POLICY 5.6.2

SUBJECT MEMORIAL MARKERS for CANADIAN MILITARY PERSONNEL

ADOPTED JUNE 28, 2007

PURPOSE:

To provide an opportunity to distinguish gravesites for Canadian military personnel interred at Regional District cemeteries.

RATIONALE:

Those who have served in Canada's armed forces have made a particular and significant contribution to the country that warrants some special recognition.

POLICY:

- The Regional District shall offer for sale a reinforced concrete base on which memorial markers commemorating Canadian Forces military personnel interred at Regional District cemeteries may be installed in authorized sections.
- 2. Persons other than family members who wish to purchase a base must provide evidence of the family's approval of the installation.
- 3. Notwithstanding the foregoing, where no family member can be located, the Regional District may grant permission to others to install a base and headstone on an unmarked grave of a Canadian Armed Forces member.
- 4. The purchaser shall bear the full cost of the base and, if required, installation as set out in the Cemetery bylaw fee schedule.
- 5. Only bases supplied by the Regional District shall be permitted.
