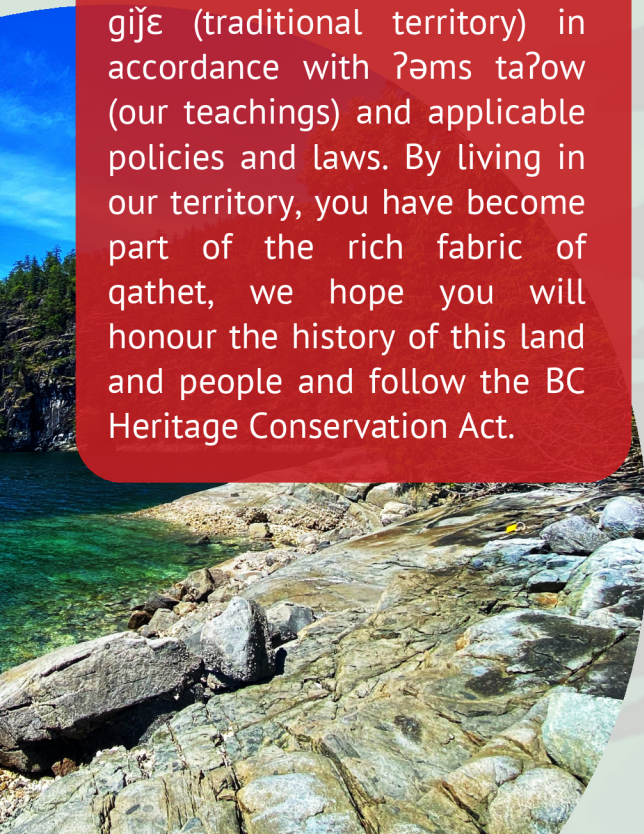




WE'RE IN IT TOGETHER...

By living in our territory, you have become part of the rich fabric of qathet, we hope you will honour the history of this land and people and follow the BC Heritage Conservation Act.

While we have regained authority for some of our traditional lands and waters, ʔəms giļe is large and continues to be faced with development and other environmental pressures. We need to have the structures and policies in place to enable us to exercise our rights, title, and interests. This will enable us to fulfill our responsibility as stewards of our entire territory and homelands and build better communities for everyone who calls this beautiful region home.

YOU SHOULD KNOW...

We take care of our culture and heritage through protection of archaeological sites.



Under the BC Heritage Conservation Act (HCA) all archaeological sites are protected. This applies whether sites are located on public or private land, and whether the site is known or unknown. Protected archaeological sites may not be altered or changed in any manner without a permit. Before you build, remodel, or conduct any ground altering activities, contact the BC archaeology branch for guidance.
